## NOTICE OF RACE for yachts of the foreign registration

### 1. Schedule of Events

July 17 (Fri.) 16:00 Skipper's meeting for overseas yacht at 4F Oirase room of ASPAM Aomori Prefecture Tourist Center

**2. Race course** The course will be from the starting line located near Aomori port, crosses Mutsu bay, the Tsugaru Channel, thence to the finish line near Irifune fishing port of Hakodate .

**3. Organizing Authority** Seikan cup yacht race executive committee

**4. Cosponsor** Gaiyo Tsugarukaikyo, Gaiyo Hokkaido, Aomori Sailing Federation, Hokkaido Sailing Federation, Minami Hokkaido Gaiyo Hanso Kyoukai, Aomori Sailing Club and others

**5. Entering a Race** To enter a race, a yacht shall comply with the safety requirements of the national organizing authority safety rules.

5-1 The minimum number for each yacht crew is two.

5-2 Entry fee ORC class ¥12000 Open class ¥20000 Crew ¥4000/person

### 6. Class

6-1 ORC class: This class is open to mono-hull yachts only with valid ORC club rating certificate.

6-2 OPEN class: This class is open to all yachts; rating shall be given by the race committee without any comment.

## 7. Rules

7-1 The race will be governed by Racing Rule of Sailing (RRS) 2009-2012,

7-2 All competitors must wear life-jacket or other adequate personal buoyancy during the race.

7-3 High speed catamaran ferry are sailing frequently with 36knots at race area.

For the safety, these equipments are required to entering The Seikan cup yacht race.

- a. One or more radar-reflector
- b. Navigation lights

7-4 All yachts must be equipped with a VHF radio; frequencies are Ch16, Ch69 International VHF Channels

7-5 It is decided if a participant wishes to protest they must use flag "B".

7-6 Sailing Instructions will be available by Skipper meeting July 17(Fri.), 2009.
